

Activity: Google Review Reflections

When students are in a space designed to provide them with the best experience, every part of them should feel as if they are welcomed and that they matter because we have communicated that to them both verbally and non-verbally. How do you plan to ensure that you are constantly and consistently providing 5 star service to all of your guest?

In Your Classroom:

1. Make copies of the Google Review Reflection and distribute to students.
2. At conclusion of each class period, allow students to reflect over class period (students can submit anonymously)
3. Use students reflections as a tool to engage students in a conversation about the glows, grows, and goals of the classroom.

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
